I am very interested in visiting your church family, and the boys and girls in their Sunday school, to talk about missions and the wonderful stories of heroes in missions presented in this series of books, in the hope of seeing hundreds of families, youth and children, being called and commissioned to serve in what ever way the LORD leads them. I am happy to sign books and work with you to promote the sale of this wonderful series.

By advertising in your news letter that I am coming and why, will help families in your church to come prepared to purchase books and take advantage of the opportunity. I am also as an outreach, visiting state schools who have our *Exceptional Books New Zealand* set, *Smelly Locks* and the *Wolf's Revenge* written by Peter Mountain that we self published.
